Victories in Christ

“I just need someone to love me,” cried Carla as she staggered into my Sunday school classroom. Leaving the children with coloring sheets and a competent helper, I silently prayed “God please help me” as I went to deal with this feeding center mom who had obviously come to church drunk. “Nobody has ever told me they love me,” she continued to cry. Tears streamed down my face as well as I hugged her and said, “I love you, and God loves you.” Not knowing what else to do because of her condition, I prayed with her and sent her home. Shortly thereafter, Carla reconciled with the Lord, and is now attending church services faithfully along with her four boys. She just completed a discipleship class and is using her artistic abilities to make posters and decorations for the children’s classes. It is amazing to see how the Lord has changed her life!

This is just one example of the victories in Christ at our new church in Ciudad Quetzal. Just recently, 5 MANNA feeding center moms have been reached for the Lord, making a total of 12 precious souls just this month that have accepted Christ as their personal Savior at this church. These new believers are burdened for their family and friends and are doing a great job of bringing their loved ones to the services. Many are also coming to Bible Study during the week, and 9 ladies just completed a Biblical discipleship course.

The other new church plant and MANNA feeding center located in La Gomera is continuing to reach people for Christ. Under the leadership of Pastor Dagoberto from BBFI Mexico, 25 have been saved and 14 baptized in the past few months. We recently had the privilege of bringing a team from 1st Baptist Church in Bel Air, Maryland to La Gomera. The group worked side by side with Guatemalans to build a roof and pour a cement floor where both the church meets and where the 80 feeding center children are fed. This is a huge blessing for the feeding center, especially now in the middle of rainy season!



We are pleased to announce that Team Guatemala has a new addition— **Kaitlynn Dixon**! She was just approved in May as a BBFI TEAM missionary to Guatemala, and is currently raising funds to join us on the field by the summer of 2012. She served with us as an intern last summer and gained experience working with children and youth, assisting in ladies ministries, and helping host groups. She will be a great asset to our team!
