Rain, Rain, Go Away

Because of this year's record amounts of rain, many Guatemalans are suffering from hunger. According to recent statistics, over 54,000 families are struggling due to severe food shortages and due to the damage that the rains have caused on their crops of corn and beans - and that number is increasing every week. Almost 50 percent of children in Guatemala are malnourished, which is the highest rate in Latin America and one of the highest in the world.

So what can we, as missionaries, do to help? One answer is through feeding the children and helping meet their physical as well as spiritual needs. We are very thankful that the Sumpango church and MANNA feeding center is continuing to reach the needs of the community. **The Ciudad Quetzal church and MANNA feeding center will open in November, and our third MANNA feeding center has just opened in a town called La Gomera.** (Read more info below.) We praise the Lord for His great blessings and for the opportunity to reach more with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Our family has been extremely busy the past few months, with normal ministry responsibilities, a new church plant in the works, and hosting a number of mission teams.

*In July, a team from Grace Bible Baptist Church in Leesburg, Florida, came and presented dramas in the local schools. They performed in over a dozen sessions and were able to present the gospel to over 2,800 students. **Over 35 accepted Christ as their Savior!**

*Also in July, New Testament Baptist Church in Largo, Florida, sent a group of teens to do work projects, provide special music, and to minister through puppets in a special Bible Kids Club. Many new kids and parents came, and we have since seen a steady increase in our Saturday kids club attendance.

*In August, 2 teams came down with Chuck Ward and MANNA Worldwide. The Lord touched many hearts on those trips, and as a result, a new MANNA center has begun in La Gomera, Escuintla. This is an area with a lot of poverty and malnutrition, located on the Pacific coast about 2 hours away from Guatemala City. This new feeding program will be out of a church plant started by Mexican BBFI missionary, Dagoberto Castañeda. This is a great opportunity to make a difference in these kids' lives, and we are excited to have a part in another new MANNA feeding center.

Thank you to those who gave to help us purchase a ministry vehicle. We recently purchased a 15-passenger van that will be used for church needs as well as for the mission teams who come to visit. We praise God for this big answer to prayer!
